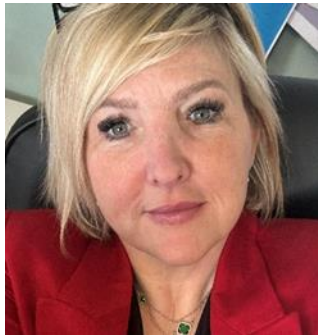


In future there will be two new features, one will be “Meet the Team” and the other will be “Meet the Service User. There’s no better place to start than at the top.....
