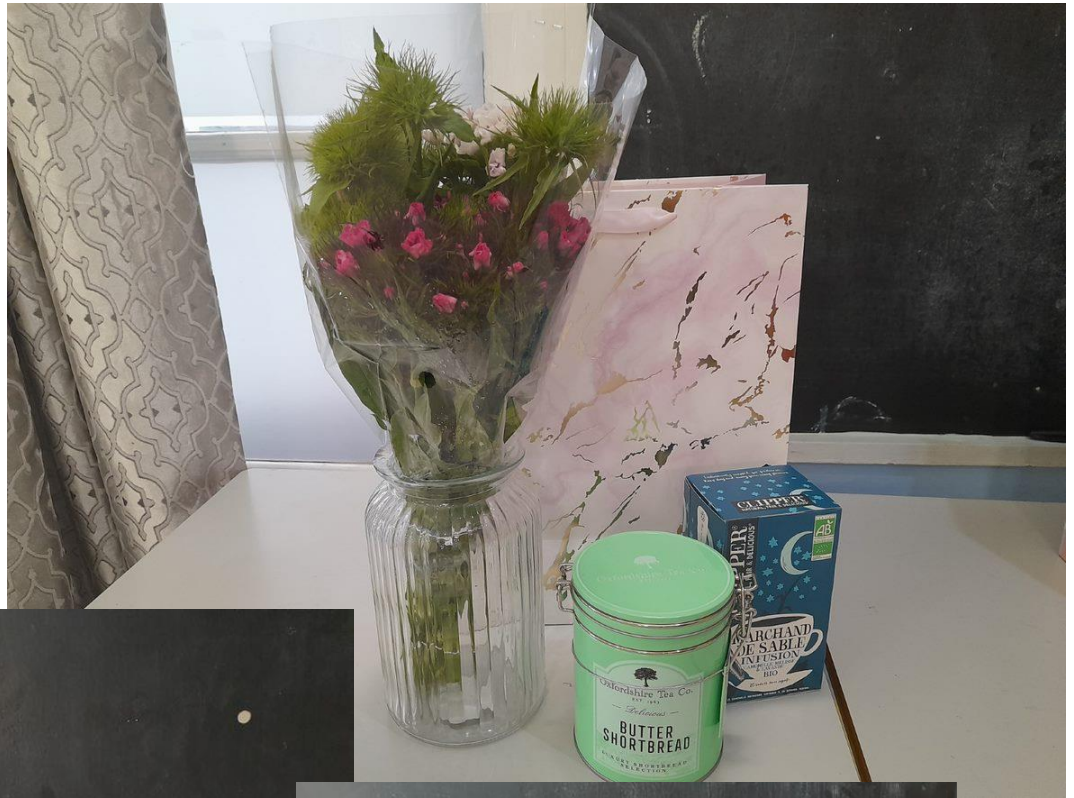

Thankfully there were lots of dry days for gang to go to the cycling. Ryan on the right with Caroline.

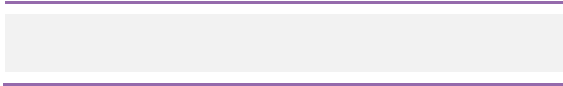


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Alexander on the left enjoying the tricycle!

In-service day training

All staff took part in positive behaviour training on the 14th of June 2023.

Positive behaviour support (PBS) is 'a person centred' framework for providing long-term support to people with a learning disability, and/or autism, including those with mental health conditions, who have, or may be at risk of developing, behaviours that challenge.

Principle of PBS

- Person-centred: ensuring the person is always at the centre.
- Partnership: working closely with the person and their supporters to shape the process.
- Planned: creating a clear and positive Behaviour Support Plan (BSP) to ensure shared understandings and accountability.

From the training all staff will create a positive behaviour support plan for service users. Allowing structured plans to put in place for all staff to follow the strategies, focussing on a person centre approach.
